WATERTOWN, N.Y. — Clarence T. Waters, 87, of 15994 Outer Ives Street, died Thursday afternoon at his home where he had been under the care of his son, Tom Waters, Henderson, and Hospice of Jefferson County.

Born Aug. 19, 1922, in McCormick, S.C., he enlisted in the Army March 25, 1941, serving in Ardennes, Central Europe and Normandy, Northern France, as a machine gunner, earning five bronze stars.

Following his discharge Oct. 13, 1945, he worked for John Mannville doing roofing and siding. Later he worked at the New York Airbrake, Watertown, then at Sicard Industries, Watertown, as a welder, retiring in 1987.

He married Catherine F. Prevost on Jan. 7, 1944, in Lebanon, Pa. The couple lived in the Watertown area all their married life. Mrs. Waters died Sept. 17, 1992.

Surviving besides his son, Thomas F. Waters, Henderson; are a daughter, Debra W. Martin, Albany; a grandson, Thomas C. Waters; a brother, Grady Waters, Dearing, Ga.; and several nieces and nephews.

Mr. Waters was a member of the 5th Armored Division Association and the American Legion, Watertown.
